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Chapter One

Before You Begin: Deepening Your Practice

Volume 3 assumes you have worked through the fundamentals. You know how to cleanse a space, dress a candle, cast a circle, and speak an incantation with genuine belief. You have a Book of Shadows — even if it is just a notebook with scattered entries. You have felt magic move in your life.

This chapter is a recalibration before we go deeper. Three things to establish before beginning any working in this volume.

1. Your Energetic Baseline

Before beginning any spell in this volume, take a moment to assess your own energetic state. Ask yourself honestly: Am I grounded? Am I in fear, anger, or desperation? Am I trying to force an outcome rather than invite one?

Advanced magic is more powerful — which means it is also more sensitive to the state of the caster. A working cast from desperation pulls desperation-frequency results. A working cast from calm confidence pulls confidence-frequency results. If you are in a difficult emotional state, cleanse first (Chapter Sixteen), ground yourself, then proceed.

2. Your Magical Journal

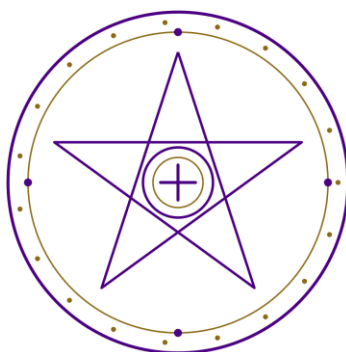
By Volume 3 you should have a dedicated magical journal — not just the spell notes pages, but a place where you record patterns, dreams, signs, synchronicities, and observations about your practice. If you do not have one, start tonight. The most powerful magical tool you will ever own is the record of your own results.

3. The Rule of Returns — Advanced Understanding

By now you know that magic returns to its caster. In Volume 3 we work with more powerful traditions — ancestral energy, elemental forces, deep reversal work. The rule of returns becomes more important, not less. Always ask before casting: would I be comfortable if this energy returned to me threefold? If the answer is no, reconsider the working.

Your Protection Sigil

The Witchy Wendy Protection Sigil from Volume 1 should be charged and active in your space. Retrace it, recharge it, and carry it before beginning any working in this volume. As a reminder:

Chapter Two

Protection First — Advanced Warding

In Volumes 1 and 2 we covered foundational protection: salt lines, the witch bottle, the uncrossing bath, the protection sigil. This chapter goes further. These workings create layered, sustained, intelligent protection that adapts to ongoing threats rather than simply sealing a door once.

Spell 1: The Four Corners Ward — Complete House Protection

A powerful quarterly ritual to seal your home at all four compass points. Best cast at the New Moon.

You Will Need

- Black salt
- Rosemary oil
- Four black candles
- Four small mirrors (pocket mirrors work perfectly)
- A compass (your phone compass is fine)

Steps

Find the four compass corners of your home — North, South, East, and West. You will place a ward at each one.

Begin at the North (Earth direction). Place a small mirror face-outward against the wall, anoint it with rosemary oil, and sprinkle black salt in a half-circle in front of it. Light the black candle beside it and say:

"North ward, Earth ward, I seal this corner. Nothing harmful enters from this direction. The earth absorbs all

that is sent against this home. This corner is sealed."

Move clockwise to East (Air). Repeat the same actions:

"East ward, Air ward, I seal this corner. No ill wind carries harm to this home. Every breath within these walls is clean and safe. This corner is sealed."

South (Fire):

"South ward, Fire ward, I seal this corner. No burning malice reaches these walls. The fire of this home warms only those who are welcome. This corner is sealed."

West (Water):

"West ward, Water ward, I seal this corner. No flood of ill will breaches this home. The waters of this household run clean and clear. This corner is sealed."

Return to the centre of your home. Face each direction once more and say:

"Four corners sealed. Four directions warded. This home stands protected at every point of the compass. What enters does so with peace or not at all. The ward holds. So it is."

Leave the candles to burn down. Leave the mirrors in place. Refresh the salt and re-anoint the mirrors each New Moon.

Spell 2: The Iron Ward — Personal Psychic Shield

*A daily shielding practice that builds in strength over time.
Best done each morning.*

You Will Need

- A piece of iron or steel (a nail, a key, any iron object)
- Black pepper
- Frankincense oil or olive oil

Steps

Iron has been used as a ward against psychic attack and negative energy across virtually every magical tradition on earth. Carry a small piece of iron on your person — a nail in your pocket works perfectly.

Each morning, hold the iron piece in your dominant hand. Anoint it with a drop of frankincense oil. Sprinkle a tiny pinch of black pepper over it. Close your fist around it and say:

"Iron shields me. Iron grounds me. Iron turns back everything sent against me. I walk through this day protected at every step. No ill eye sees me. No harmful intention reaches me. I am shielded by the strength of earth itself."

Carry the iron piece in your pocket or bag throughout the day. At night, place it beside your bed. Cleanse it under running water weekly and re-anoint it.

Spell 3: Ancestor Shield Ritual — Call Your Bloodline to Guard You

A powerful working that activates your ancestral lineage as a protective force around you.

You Will Need

- A white candle
- A glass of water
- Something representing your ancestors (a family photo, an old object, or simply their names written on paper)
- Florida water or plain water with a drop of cologne

Steps

Set the white candle, the glass of water, and your ancestral object on a clean surface. This is your temporary ancestor altar. Sprinkle a few drops of Florida water around the space. Light the white candle. Take three slow breaths. Then speak aloud — call your ancestors by name if you know them, or call them by relationship if you do not:

"I call to my ancestors. Those who came before me, those whose blood runs in my veins, those who loved me before I was born. I call to my grandmothers and grandfathers, my great-grandmothers and great-grandfathers, and all those who stand behind them in the long line of my blood. Come close. Stand with me. Shield me with the strength of all the generations that made me."

Sit quietly for five minutes, feeling the weight and warmth of generations gathering around you. Then say:

"I am not alone. I have never been alone. The protection of my lineage surrounds me always. I walk forward"

***carrying all of you with me. Guard me
as I guard your memory. Thank you."***

Leave the candle and water on the altar until the candle burns out. Pour the water outside — it carries your gratitude to your ancestors. Repeat this ritual monthly.

Chapter Three

Ancestral & Spirit Work

Ancestral magic is one of the oldest and most powerful forms of spiritual practice on earth. In virtually every culture — West African, European, Asian, Indigenous American — the ancestors are understood to be active participants in the lives of their living descendants. They are not gone. They have simply changed form.

This chapter teaches you to build a relationship with your ancestral line, ask for their guidance and help, honour them appropriately, and receive their protection. This is sacred work. Approach it with respect, gratitude, and genuine intention.

A note: you do not need to know your ancestors' names to work with them. Blood lineage is one form of ancestral connection, but ancestors of the heart — teachers, mentors, beloved friends who have passed — are equally available to you. You may also work with elevated ancestors: those who lived lives of wisdom and service, even if they are not blood relations.

Setting Up Your Ancestor Altar

An ancestor altar is a dedicated space where you honour and communicate with those who have passed. It does not need to be elaborate. A small shelf, a corner of a table, or even a windowsill will serve. What matters is the intention.

- A white cloth to cover the surface
- Photographs or names of ancestors written on paper
- A glass of fresh water — changed weekly (water is the bridge between worlds)
- A white candle — lit when you communicate with them
- Something they loved in life if you know them (a food they enjoyed, a flower they grew)

- Incense — frankincense or copal are traditional

Never place food or water on an ancestor altar that you would not eat or drink yourself. Never place photographs of living people on an ancestor altar.

Spell 4: Opening the Ancestor Connection — First Communication Ritual

For those beginning ancestor work for the first time. Best cast on a Monday evening.

You Will Need

- A white candle
- Fresh water in a clear glass
- Incense (frankincense, copal, or sandalwood)
- Paper and pen

Steps

Set up your ancestor altar space. Write the names of any ancestors you know on the paper. If you know none, simply write "My Beloved Ancestors" at the top of the page.

Light the incense. Light the white candle. Place the glass of fresh water on the altar. Sit quietly for a moment, feeling the space settle. Then speak:

"I open this connection with love and respect. I am [your name], daughter/son/child of [your parent's name], grandchild of [grandparent's name if known]. I come to this altar to honour those who came before me and to begin building a bridge between us. I ask nothing today except to acknowledge your presence and your love. If you are with me, let me feel you."

Sit in silence for at least ten minutes. Notice any warmth, any scent, any sudden emotion, any image that comes to mind.

These are often how ancestors communicate. Write down anything you notice.

When you are ready to close, say:

"Thank you for your presence. Thank you for your love. I will return. The altar stands open for you always. Go in peace and return in peace."

Leave the candle burning safely until it extinguishes. Change the water weekly. Visit the altar regularly, even just to light the candle and say thank you.

Spell 5: Ancestral Petition — Asking Your Ancestors for Help

Once you have established a connection, this working asks your ancestors to intervene in a specific situation.

You Will Need

- White candle
- Fresh water
- Incense
- Paper and pen
- A small offering — a piece of fruit, a cup of coffee or tea, something sweet

Steps

Place the offering on the altar alongside the water and candle. Light the incense and the candle. Spend a few minutes in quiet acknowledgement of your ancestors' presence.

On the paper, write your request clearly and specifically. Not "I need help" but "I am asking for your support in [specific situation]. I would like [specific outcome]."

Hold the paper and speak aloud:

"Beloved ancestors, I come to you today with a need. You know my life. You know my heart. You have walked paths I am only beginning. I ask you now to stand with me in this — [state your request aloud, in your own words]. I do not demand. I ask. I trust your wisdom about what is truly best for me. Guide me, support me, and if this is right, open the way."

Place the paper under the candle. Leave the offering on the altar for 24 hours, then take it outside and leave it on the earth as a gift to your ancestors. Repeat this working for three consecutive Mondays for a significant request.

Spell 6: Ancestral Healing Ritual — Break Inherited Patterns

Some patterns — poverty, broken relationships, ill health, fear — run through family lines across generations. This working asks your ancestors to help break those cycles.

You Will Need

- A white candle and a black candle
- Paper and pen
- Scissors
- A fireproof bowl

Steps

On the paper, write the pattern you wish to break. Be specific: "The pattern of financial struggle that has run through my family line." or "The pattern of broken love relationships." or "The pattern of fear that was passed down to me."

Light the white candle first (representing the healed version of your lineage) and the black candle (representing the pattern being released). Place them side by side.

Hold the paper and say:

"I call to my elevated ancestors — those who are healed, those who stand in wisdom and love beyond this pattern. I ask your help today. This pattern has lived long enough in our line. With your help and mine, it ends here. It ends with me. I release it on behalf of myself and all who come after me. The cycle is broken. The line is healed."

Take the scissors and cut the paper into pieces. Burn them in the fireproof bowl using the black candle's flame. As they burn, say: "Released. Healed. Done." Let the white candle continue to burn, representing the new pattern taking root.

Spell 7: Ancestor Dream Request — Receive Guidance While You Sleep

Ask a specific ancestor to visit you in a dream and offer guidance.

You Will Need

- A white candle (burn for 30 minutes before bed, then extinguish safely)
- A photograph or name of the ancestor you wish to contact
- Lavender or mugwort under your pillow
- Your dream journal beside the bed

Steps

Thirty minutes before bed, light the white candle. Place the photograph or name before it. Speak directly to that ancestor as you would speak to a living person:

"[Name or relationship], I am thinking of you tonight. I miss you and I carry you with me always. I have a question I would like your guidance on: [state your question clearly]. If it is possible, please come to me tonight in my dreams and show me what I need to see. I will be listening."

Extinguish the candle safely (do not leave it burning while sleeping). Place lavender or mugwort under your pillow. Keep your dream journal open beside the bed. The moment you wake, write immediately — before speaking to anyone, before checking your phone. Even fragments, colours, and feelings. The answer is often in what seems most ordinary.

Chapter Four

Elemental Magic: Fire, Water, Earth & Air

The four classical elements — Fire, Water, Earth, and Air — are not merely symbols. They are energetic forces that permeate all of reality. Every herb, crystal, day, planet, and spell type corresponds to one or more of these elements. Working directly with the elements — rather than simply using their correspondences — dramatically amplifies any magical working.

Each element has its own personality, its own domain of influence, and its own way of communicating. Learning to work with them directly is one of the most significant advances a practitioner can make.

Element Correspondences at a Glance

Element • Direction • Season • Best For • Time of Day

Fire

Direction: South

Season: Summer

Best For: Passion, courage, transformation, destruction of the old, purification

Time of Day: Noon

Water

Direction: West

Season: Autumn

Best For: Emotions, love, dreams, psychic work, healing, flow

Time of Day: Dusk

Earth

Direction: North

Season: Winter

Best For: Money, stability, grounding, protection, manifestation

Time of Day: Midnight

Air

Direction: East

Season: Spring

Best For: Communication, intellect, new beginnings, travel, clarity

Time of Day: Dawn

Spell 8: Fire Spell — Transformation Burning Ritual

Fire destroys what no longer serves and transforms it into energy for new creation. This spell uses fire directly as the working agent.

You Will Need

- A large fireproof bowl or cauldron
- Paper and pen
- Matches or a lighter
- Something representing what you want to transform (a written description, a photograph, an object that represents the old situation)

Steps

Set the fireproof bowl on a stable surface, ideally outdoors or near an open window. Write on the paper everything you wish to transform — not just eliminate, but transform. Fire does not simply destroy; it converts energy.

Hold the paper and connect with the element of Fire. Feel its energy — dynamic, consuming, purifying, brilliant. Say:

"Element of Fire, I call to you. Ancient force of transformation, I ask your help. Take what I offer you and burn away everything that has kept me from my highest good. Convert this old energy into fuel for my new beginning."

***Transform, do not merely destroy. I
trust your wisdom."***

Light the paper and let it burn completely in the bowl. Watch the smoke rise and know that the energy is being transformed. When the ashes are cool, take them outside and scatter them in the wind or bury them in the earth — completing the elemental cycle.

Spell 9: Water Spell — Emotional Release & Flow

Water carries, heals, and releases. This spell uses water directly to process and release stuck emotions.

You Will Need

- A large bowl of water
- Sea salt
- Flower petals (any colour appropriate to your intention)
- A candle beside the bowl

Steps

Add sea salt and flower petals to the bowl of water. Light the candle beside it. Place your hands in the water and call to the element:

"Element of Water, I call to you. Ancient force of emotion and flow, I ask your help. Everything I carry that is stagnant, blocked, or frozen — help me release it. You know how to move. Teach my energy to move with you."

Spend at least ten minutes with your hands in the water, allowing any emotion that needs to surface to do so. Do not suppress anything that comes up. Water is the element of emotional truth. When you feel complete, pour the water outside onto the earth, releasing everything it carries.

Spell 10: Earth Spell — Manifestation Planting Ritual

Earth is the element of physical manifestation — what you plant in earth, grows. This spell literally plants your intention.

You Will Need

- A small pot of soil or access to earth outdoors
- A seed (any seed — even a herb seed from your kitchen)
- Paper and pen
- Water

Steps

Write your intention on a small piece of paper — what you wish to manifest in the physical world. Be specific and present-tense. Fold the paper small.

Hold the seed in one hand and the paper in the other. Call to the element:

"Element of Earth, I call to you. Ancient force of manifestation and stability, I ask your help. I plant this intention in you as I plant this seed. As this seed grows, so grows my intention in the physical world. Nourish what I have planted. Bring it into form."

Dig a small hole in the soil. Place the folded paper at the bottom. Plant the seed on top. Cover with earth. Water it. Tend it. As the seed grows, your manifestation grows with it. If the plant thrives, your intention is taking root. If it struggles, revisit your working.

Spell 11: Air Spell — Clarity & New Beginnings Breath Work

Air is the element of the mind, communication, and new beginnings. This spell clears mental fog and opens fresh pathways.

You Will Need

- An open window or outdoor space where the wind blows
- A white feather (or any light feather)
- Paper and pen
- A pinch of dried lavender or mint

Steps

Stand at the open window or outdoors. Feel the air moving around you. Write your intention on the paper — what clarity or new beginning you are calling for.

Hold the feather up and call to the element:

"Element of Air, I call to you. Ancient force of thought and new beginnings, I ask your help. Clear the fog from my mind. Open new pathways where I have been blocked. Carry my intention where it needs to go. As you are free, make me free."

Tear the paper into small pieces. Place them in your palm along with the pinch of lavender or mint. Hold your palm up and blow everything into the wind, releasing your intention to the element of Air. Know that your message has been sent and will return to you in the form of clarity, ideas, and open doors.

Chapter Five

The Complete Jar Spell Guide

We introduced honey jars in Volume 1. This chapter is the complete guide to jar spells — one of the most powerful, versatile, and time-honoured traditions in folk magic. A jar spell creates a contained energetic environment that works continuously, day and night, for as long as it remains sealed and in place.

The principle is always the same: what you put inside the jar creates the energy the jar radiates. Sweet ingredients sweeten situations. Sour or sharp ingredients create conflict or banishment. Protective ingredients ward and guard. The jar is sealed and the energy is activated by a candle burned on its lid.

The Golden Rules of Jar Spells

- Always write the target's name (or your own) on paper placed inside the jar first
- Layer ingredients intentionally — the order matters energetically
- Seal with wax from a candle in the appropriate colour
- Place the jar where it will not be disturbed and where it relates to your intention (money jars near where you work, love jars near your bed, protection jars near your door)
- Never open a sealed jar unless you are dissolving the working
- To dissolve a working: take the jar outside, open it, pour the contents into the earth, and bury the empty jar or dispose of it away from your home

Spell 12: War Water Jar — Protection Against Active Enemies

War water is a traditional hoodoo working used when someone is actively causing harm. This jar creates a contained field of protective discord around you that repels hostile energy.

You Will Need

- A glass jar with a tight lid
- Iron nails (rusty ones if possible — available at hardware stores)
- Black salt
- Black pepper
- Cayenne pepper
- Vinegar
- The enemy's name on paper (or a general description if you don't know who is targeting you: 'those who wish me harm')
- A black candle

Steps

Place the paper with the enemy's name or description at the bottom of the jar. Add the iron nails (these rust in the vinegar, creating the powerful protective compound known as war water). Add the black salt, black pepper, and cayenne. Fill the jar with vinegar.

Before sealing, say:

"This jar holds the confusion, the discord, and the return of all harm sent against me. Every attack that comes toward me is captured here. Every ill wish is turned and returned. I am untouchable. I am protected. The iron rusts and the rust is justice."

Seal the jar tightly. Light the black candle and drip wax over the lid to seal the working. Place the jar outside your home — by the front gate, near the boundary of your property — facing outward. Do not bring it inside. Let the nails rust inside the vinegar. The working grows stronger over time.

Spell 13: Money Drawing Jar — Continuous Abundance

A more powerful version of the Prosperity Jar from Volume 2, this working uses layered ingredients for sustained financial attraction.

You Will Need

- A wide glass jar
- Your name and a financial goal written on green paper
- Honey
- Cinnamon sticks
- Dried basil
- Bay leaves
- Five coins (odd numbers are traditional in money magic)
- A piece of citrine or pyrite
- Green ribbon
- A green candle

Steps

Place your name paper at the bottom, face up. Layer in the coins, then the citrine or pyrite, then the basil and bay leaves, then the cinnamon sticks. Pour honey over everything until the jar is three-quarters full. Tie the green ribbon around the outside of the jar in a bow.

Seal the jar. Light the green candle on the lid and let it burn down. Place the jar in the area of your home where you manage money. Every Thursday, hold the jar and say your financial goal aloud once, then shake it gently three times.

Chapter Six

Petition Magic: Writing to the Universe

A petition is a written request directed to a spiritual force — the universe, your ancestors, a deity, or the energy of your own highest self. Petition magic is one of the most precise and powerful forms of spellwork available, because it requires you to commit your exact desire to paper in words — which forces absolute clarity of intention.

Vague petition, vague result. Precise petition, precise result. This is the law of petition magic, and it is why many practitioners find that their spell results improve dramatically once they begin writing petitions rather than simply speaking intentions.

The Seven Rules of Petition Writing

- Write in the present tense: ‘I have’ not ‘I want’
- Be specific: name amounts, dates, people, situations exactly
- Write in the positive: what you want, not what you don’t want
- Write from a place of gratitude, as though it has already arrived
- Keep it to one page or less — focused energy is more powerful than sprawling intention
- Sign your name at the bottom with your full legal name
- State your name nine times in the body of the petition to anchor it to you

Spell 16: The Master Petition — Writing Your Most Important Request

For your single most significant desire — the one that, if it manifested, would change everything.

You Will Need

- Clean white paper
- A pen with red or purple ink (commanding colours)
- A candle in the appropriate colour for your goal
- Your chosen oil for anointing
- A fireproof bowl or a safe place to store the petition

Steps

Sit quietly with your candle lit. Take at least five minutes to think carefully about exactly what you want. Then write your petition, following the seven rules above.

Begin with: "In the name of all that is good and true, I [your full name] petition the universe for the following..."

Write your request fully and specifically. Sign it. Then write your name nine times in a circle around the body of the petition, forming a ring of your identity around your request.

Fold the petition toward you three times. Anoint the outside with your chosen oil. Hold it in both hands and breathe on it three times to enliven it with your life-force. Then say:

"This petition is written, sealed, and sent. The universe receives it. My request is heard. The answer is already on its way to me. I release this with complete trust and gratitude."

You may burn the petition immediately (the smoke carries it), bury it in the earth (to grow), place it under a candle to burn over seven days, or seal it in a jar. Choose based on your intuition.

Chapter Seven

Mirror Magic: The Complete Chapter

Mirrors occupy a unique position in magical tradition worldwide. In virtually every culture, mirrors are understood to be portals — to the self, to other realms, and to the unseen world. They reflect, they reveal, they deflect, and they store energy. A mirror that has been used in magical workings over time becomes a charged object of considerable power.

Volume 1 introduced the glamour mirror. This chapter is the complete guide to mirror magic, covering scrying, reflection workings, the black mirror, and advanced protection uses.

Caring for Your Magical Mirrors

- Keep magical mirrors covered with a dark cloth when not in use — this prevents them from absorbing ambient energy
- Cleanse a new mirror before first use: pass it through incense smoke, sprinkle it with salt water, and state your intention for it
- Never use a cracked mirror in magic — the fractured reflection creates fractured workings
- If a mirror breaks during a working, the working ends immediately. Dispose of the pieces respectfully away from your home

Spell 19: Black Mirror Scrying — Seeing Beyond the Veil

Scrying is the practice of gazing into a reflective surface to receive psychic information, images, and guidance. The black mirror is the most powerful scrying tool available.

You Will Need

- A black mirror (available at spiritual supply stores, or make your own: paint the back of a glass picture frame with black acrylic paint and let dry completely)
- A single candle placed to the side — not in front of the mirror
- A dark, quiet room
- Your journal

Steps

Sit comfortably before the black mirror in a darkened room with only the single candle for light. The candle should be placed to one side so it does not create a direct reflection in the mirror.

Anoint your third eye (between and slightly above your eyebrows) with a drop of frankincense oil. Take ten slow breaths, relaxing deeper with each exhale.

Say:

"Black mirror, clear mirror, mirror of truth. I open my sight. Show me what I need to see. I am calm. I am receptive. I receive clearly and I understand what is shown to me."

Gaze softly into the mirror — not staring hard, but gazing gently, with soft, slightly unfocused eyes. Blink normally. Breathe normally. You may see: colours, shadows, shapes, images, or simply a deep sense of knowing about something. You may see nothing at all on your first attempt — this is normal. Scrying is a skill that builds with practice.

After 10–20 minutes, close the session by covering the mirror and writing in your journal immediately. Note everything — colours, feelings, images, words, impressions. Understanding often comes later, not in the moment.

Chapter Eight

Knot & Cord Magic: The Ancient Art

Knot magic is one of the oldest documented forms of spellwork in human history. Evidence of it appears in ancient Egypt, Mesopotamia, medieval Europe, and across African and Indigenous traditions worldwide. The principle is elegant: you literally tie your intention into a physical object. The knot holds the energy. When you want to release or activate the spell, you untie or cut the knot.

Cord colour correspondences follow the same rules as candle colours. The material of the cord matters too: cotton is all-purpose and works for any intention, silk is used for love and luxury workings, leather for binding and protection, linen for abundance and harvest magic.

The Nine-Knot Cord

The nine-knot cord is the foundational working of knot magic. Nine is a number of completion, power, and the three times three. A cord with nine knots tied with specific intention becomes a powerful stored spell that releases its energy as each knot is untied — or stores it permanently as each knot is tied.

Spell 22: The Nine-Knot Manifestation Cord

A stored spell that releases energy in nine stages as each knot is untied over nine days.

You Will Need

- A cord approximately 36 inches long in the colour appropriate to your goal
- A clear intention stated in nine words or fewer
- A candle to charge the cord

Steps

Light the candle. Pass the cord through the candle's smoke three times to cleanse it. Then state your nine-word (or fewer) intention clearly. For example: "I attract love, abundance, and perfect health." or "My business thrives and grows every day."

Tie the first knot at the left end of the cord. As you tie it, say:

"By knot of one, the spell has begun."

Tie the second knot at the right end:

"By knot of two, the magic is true."

Tie the third knot in the middle:

"By knot of three, so mote it be."

Continue tying knots between the existing ones, saying for each: "By knot of four, open the door. By knot of five, the spell comes alive. By knot of six, the magic is fixed. By knot of seven, the stars in heaven. By knot of eight, I open the gate. By knot of nine, the spell is mine."

The cord is now charged. Keep it under your pillow or on your altar. Beginning on the next day, untie one knot per day for nine days, saying your intention as each one releases. By the ninth day, the full energy of the working has been released into the universe.

Travel Protection Spells

Travel opens us to new energies, new environments, and new vulnerabilities. A witch who travels without warding her journey is like one who leaves her front door unguarded. These spells protect you in transit, guard your home while you are away, and ensure safe arrival.

Spell 32: Journey Ward — Protection Before Any Travel

Cast before any significant journey — by car, plane, train, or any other means.

You Will Need

- A white candle
- Salt
- Rosemary oil
- A small piece of black tourmaline to carry with you

Steps

The night before your journey, light the white candle. Anoint the black tourmaline with rosemary oil. Hold it in both hands and say:

"I travel under protection. The road before me is safe. Every vehicle I board is guarded. Every person who guides my journey — driver, pilot, captain — is alert and competent. I arrive at my destination safely, on time, and in good health. Nothing harmful meets me on this journey. I am protected from departure to arrival."

Draw a circle of salt around the candle. Let it burn for 20 minutes. Carry the tourmaline on your person throughout the journey — in your pocket or bag, never in checked luggage.

Steps

The morning of your departure, lay fresh salt lines across every threshold. Place the bowl of black salt in the centre room of your home. Place the note under the bowl of black salt. Light the white candle briefly, say:

Anoint the stone with rosemary oil. Place it with the paper under your white candle. Light the candle and say:

"This vehicle is blessed. Every journey made in it is safe. The engine runs well. The tyres hold firm. The driver is alert and clear. Every passenger is protected. The road welcomes this car and guides it safely to every destination. I am safe every time I drive."

Advanced Domination & Influence Spells

Volumes 1 and 2 covered foundational domination: the boss fix, calamus root, command and compel. This chapter works with more sophisticated influence techniques for those situations where foundational domination has not fully resolved the issue.

Spell 35: Triple Strength Boss Fix — Command Absolute Professional Respect

For entrenched workplace situations where standard influence workings have not produced results.

You Will Need

- A purple seven-day vigil candle
- Bergamot oil
- Calamus root
- Master root (available at spiritual supply stores — the root of absolute command)
- The target's name written on paper nine times, crossed by your name nine times
- A petition stating exactly what compliance you require

Steps

This is a sustained seven-day working. Use the skewer to make three holes in the top of the purple vigil candle. Into each hole, place a pinch of calamus root, then a pinch of master root, then drop bergamot oil over both.

Place the crossed names paper and your petition under the candle. Light it on a Tuesday (Mars's day, ruler of authority and force). Say:

"For seven days this candle burns. For seven days my authority is established. [Name] hears my voice and complies. [Name] sees my work and respects it. [Name] treats me with the deference I have earned. This is not negotiable. This is not temporary. This is the new order of things. My command is rooted in the earth and cannot be moved."

Let the candle burn for the full seven days. Read the glass when it completes: clear glass means the working succeeded; if there is heavy black soot, the person is resistant and a second working may be needed.

Spell 36: Tongue Tying Spell — Silence Gossip and Slander

When someone is spreading harmful lies or gossip about you in a workplace or social environment.

You Will Need

- A piece of beef tongue from a butcher (or substitute: a large dried bay leaf written on)
- The gossip's name written on paper
- Alum powder (available at grocery stores in the spice aisle)
- Black thread
- A freezer

Steps

Write the gossip's name on the paper. Sprinkle it with alum powder (traditionally used to 'pucker and close' mouths in folk magic). Make a slit in the tongue or fold the bay leaf and place the name inside.

Wrap the black thread around it nine times, tying nine knots. Say as you tie each knot:

"Your tongue is bound. Your lies are silenced. Your gossip has no voice. Every word you speak against me falls empty to the ground and is believed by no one. Your mouth works against you now, not against me. Be still."

Wrap in plastic and place in the back of your freezer. Do not remove until the situation is fully resolved. When it is, thaw and dispose of it outside your property with thanks.

Spell Reversals: Undoing What Was Done

Magic, once cast, continues to work until it is consciously dissolved. This is both its power and its responsibility. There are three main reasons a practitioner might need to reverse a spell: the situation has changed and the outcome is no longer desired; the spell produced unintended consequences; or you cast in anger or fear and the working was not aligned with your highest good.

Reversing your own spells is a sign of mature magical practice, not failure. The most powerful practitioners know not only how to cast but how to close.

How to Know if a Spell Needs Reversing

- The situation has resolved naturally and the spell is no longer needed
- The spell is producing results but they feel ‘off’ or not what you truly wanted
- You feel a constant energetic drain since casting a particular working
- Circumstances have changed completely — the person you cast the love spell for has become harmful, for example
- Your moral or ethical position has shifted and you no longer feel the casting was right

Spell 37: The Reversal Ritual — Undo Your Own Spell

To consciously dissolve a working you cast. Can be used for any spell type.

You Will Need

- A white candle
- Salt water
- The original petition or any remaining physical component of the original spell (jar, cord, paper)
- A fireproof bowl

Steps

Gather any physical remnants of the original spell. If you have none — the candle burned and nothing remains — write a description of the original spell on paper.

Light the white candle. Sprinkle salt water over the physical remnants. Say:

"I dissolve what I created. I withdraw the intention I sent. I call back my energy completely. The working I cast on [date or description] is finished. It releases cleanly and returns all energy to its neutral state. Nothing lingers. Nothing holds. The spell is over and all its effects dissolve with respect and completeness."

Burn the remnants or the description paper in the fireproof bowl using the white candle's flame. Pour the salt water over the ashes. Take the cooled ashes outside and scatter them in running water or bury them in earth away from your home.

When you believe someone has directed a curse, hex, or working of ill will at you.

You Will Need

- A reversing candle (black on the outside, red on the inside — available at spiritual supply stores, or use a plain black candle)
- A small mirror
- Salt
- Lemon juice
- Black pepper

Steps

If you do not have a reversing candle, anoint a black candle with lemon juice and roll it in black pepper — this creates reversal energy. Place the mirror beside the candle, face-outward from you.

Draw a circle of salt around the candle. Light it and say:

"Whatever has been sent against me is turned back now. The working — known or unknown, named or unnamed — dissolves as it meets my protection. It cannot hold on me. It has no anchor in my life. Every effect it has caused begins to reverse now. I reclaim my natural state of health, abundance, and ease. The sender receives their working back threefold. I am clean. I am clear. I am free."

Let the candle burn fully. Do this for three consecutive days for a serious or long-standing hex. Follow with an uncrossing bath (Chapter Sixteen) after the final reversal candle.

“I stop this working now. What I have begun is cancelled before it completes. No intention has been sent. No energy has been committed. Everything returns to neutral. I begin again only when I am clear, calm, and certain.”

Sprinkle salt water around the working area to clear it. Wash your hands in cold water. The working is cancelled. Wait at least 24 hours and cleanse yourself with the Aura Cleanse before attempting the working again.

Wax Reading & Ceromancy

Ceromancy — the art of reading melted wax — is a form of divination that has been practiced across European, African, and Latin American spiritual traditions for centuries. When you burn a candle for a spell, the wax that drips and pools is communicating with you about the state of your working, the obstacles present, and the likely outcome.

Learning to read candle wax is a skill that develops over time. The more you work with candles and pay attention to what they show you, the more accurate and nuanced your readings become. Trust your intuition above all — the interpretation that feels right for your specific situation is almost always the correct one.

Reading Dripped Wax — What Shapes Mean

Shape • Meaning

Heart

Meaning: Love is present or incoming; the spell is working in the love arena

Circle

Meaning: Completion, wholeness, a situation coming full circle, protection is active

Cross

Meaning: A crossroads decision is coming; or opposing forces creating obstacles

Arrow pointing toward you

Meaning: Something is coming to you; the spell is drawing your desire closer

Arrow pointing away

Meaning: Something or someone is leaving; a loss or departure

Star

Meaning: Success, alignment, the universe is working with you on this

Snake

Meaning: Hidden enemies; someone is not what they appear; betrayal possible

Bird

Meaning: A message is coming; news travels toward you; communication opening

Tree or branches

Meaning: Growth is happening; your roots are strong; slow but sure progress

Coin or oval

Meaning: Money is involved; financial movement is near

Hand

Meaning: Help is coming from another person; a human intervention

Mountain

Meaning: Significant obstacles; the path is there but it requires effort

River or wavy lines

Meaning: Go with the flow; things are moving; don't force the outcome

Clear pool with no drips

Meaning: Clean burn; the working is strong and unobstructed

The Full Wax Reading Ritual

Spell 39: Candle Wax Divination — Reading Your Spell's Outcome

A deliberate ceromancy session to understand the state of a current working.

You Will Need

- A white candle (white is neutral and produces the clearest wax readings)
- A dark-coloured plate or bowl of cold water
- Your journal

Steps

Light the white candle. State your question clearly aloud: "Show me the state of my [name the working] spell. Show me what I need to know about this situation."

Let the candle burn for 20–30 minutes, allowing significant wax to pool and drip. Then tilt the candle and deliberately pour the melted wax into the cold water. The wax hardens instantly into shapes.

Examine the hardened wax shapes in the water from all angles — above, from the side, upside down. Note every shape, every suggestion of form. Write them all in your journal without immediately interpreting them.

Then sit quietly with your journal and ask yourself: "What do these shapes mean for my specific situation?" Trust the first interpretation that comes. Cross-reference with the shapes table above if needed, but always let your own intuition have the final word.

A sustained daily wax reading practice that shows you how a working is developing over time.

You Will Need

- Seven white candles

Steps

Perform this over seven consecutive days after casting a significant spell. Each day at the same time, light a fresh candle. State the name of the spell you are tracking. Let it burn for 20 minutes. Pour the wax into cold water and read the shapes.

Record every shape in your journal. After seven days, review the full sequence. Look for:

- Progression — shapes that grow more positive across the week signal the spell is gaining strength
- Stagnation — the same shape repeating suggests the spell is blocked at one point

To read the energetic state of a specific person using candle wax.

Dream Interpretation Guide

Volume 2 taught you to use dreams as a channel for magical communication: dream pillows, dream messaging, moon water psychic brew. This chapter teaches you to read and understand what your dreams are already telling you — because your subconscious mind, your ancestors, and your higher self are communicating with you every single night.

Dreams speak in symbols, not sentences. Learning the language of your own dreaming mind is one of the most valuable skills a practitioner can develop. Keep your dream journal beside your bed and write immediately on waking — even fragments, even a single colour or emotion. The practice of recording dreams consistently is what opens the channel.

Universal Dream Symbols in Magical Tradition

Symbol • Common Meaning in Magical Dreams

Water (calm)

Common Meaning in Magical Dreams: Emotional peace, psychic clarity, flow, things going well

Water (stormy)

Common Meaning in Magical Dreams: Emotional turbulence, a situation that needs attention

Fire

Common Meaning in Magical Dreams: Transformation, passion, warning, purification needed

Snake

Common Meaning in Magical Dreams: Transformation, hidden wisdom, a deceptive person nearby, shedding the old

Teeth falling out

Common Meaning in Magical Dreams: Fear of loss, anxiety about communication, a transition approaching

Write down the recurring dream in as much detail as you can. Every image, every emotion, every detail.

Anoint the white candle with lavender oil. Light it. Read your dream description aloud, then say:

"This dream is a message. I am ready to receive it clearly. Tonight in my dreams, the meaning of this recurring vision will be made plain to me. I will understand what you are showing me. I am listening. I am open. Speak plainly."

Most people dream passively — receiving whatever their subconscious produces. A practitioner can learn to set the direction of their dreaming, using the hours of sleep as active magical working time.

Each night before sleep, anoint your temples with lavender oil if using. In your notebook, write one clear question or intention for your dreams tonight. Not a wish list — one thing: “Show me what I need to know about my career.” “Give me insight into this relationship.”

Read the question aloud once, softly, then say:

“Dreaming mind, I give you your task tonight. While my body rests, my deeper mind works. Show me what I need. Speak clearly. I will remember and I will understand.”

The moment you wake, before anything else, write whatever you remember — even a single word, a colour, a feeling. The answer is almost always there in the first thirty seconds of waking consciousness before the rational mind covers it.

Spell 52: Shared Dream Ritual — Meet Someone in the Dream Space

An advanced working to arrange a meeting in the dream space with someone you wish to communicate with.

You Will Need

- A photograph of the person
- A white candle
- Lavender or mugwort
- Two matching small objects — one to keep, one to imagine sending to the other person

Steps

This working is most effective when both parties know it is happening and have agreed to it. Hold both matching objects. Charge one for yourself by breathing on it: “This is my presence.” Charge the other by holding it over the photograph: “This carries my intention to [name].”

Light the white candle. Place lavender or mugwort under your pillow. Hold your object and say:

“Tonight in the dream space, [name] and I meet. The distance between us dissolves in sleep. We communicate what needs to be said, what needs to be heard, what cannot be expressed in waking life. I come in peace and openness. I will remember what passes between us.”

Sleep with your charged object in your hand or under your pillow. Write your dream immediately on waking. Even if you do not remember the meeting directly, the messages that come through will relate to this person.

Advanced Cleansing & Uncrossing

Volumes 1 and 2 covered foundational cleansing: smoke cleanse, aura cleanse, uncrossing bath, vinegar cleanse. This chapter introduces advanced cleansing techniques for heavy or persistent energetic conditions — when standard cleansing has not fully resolved the issue.

Spell 41: The Seven-Day Uncrossing Ritual — Complete Spiritual Reset

For serious energetic conditions: persistent bad luck, a sense of spiritual heaviness, or when you believe a significant working has been done against you.

You Will Need

- Hyssop herb
- Sea salt
- Lemon juice
- Rue herb (if available — a powerful uncrossing herb)
- Seven white candles (one per day)
- A white outfit or white towel to wrap yourself in after the bath

Steps

For seven consecutive days, beginning at the New Moon, prepare an uncrossing bath. Steep hyssop and rue (if using) in boiling water for five minutes. Add sea salt and lemon juice to your bath. Step in.

On each day, light that day's white candle beside the bath. Pour the bathwater over your head three times, saying:

"Day [number] of my cleansing. What was placed upon me dissolves. Each day I am cleaner. Each day I am freer. Each

day the condition lifts further. By the seventh day I am completely restored to my natural state of health, luck, and ease."

On the seventh day, add the additional declaration:

"Seven days complete. I am cleansed. I am whole. I am restored. The condition is finished and I begin again from a clean foundation."

Wrap yourself in white after the final bath. Spend at least one hour in quiet, positive activity — reading, gentle music, prayer, gratitude journaling. You have done significant spiritual work and your energy needs time to settle.

Spell 42: Egg Cleanse — Advanced Reading and Removal

The egg cleanse (limpieza con huevo in Latin American tradition) removes spiritual impurities and allows you to read what was removed.

You Will Need

- One fresh raw egg, at room temperature
- A glass of cold water
- Salt
- Rue or rosemary
- A white candle

Steps

Light the white candle. Hold the egg in your dominant hand. Beginning at the top of your head, roll the egg slowly over your entire body — front and back, arms, legs, the soles of your feet. Take your time. Feel the egg drawing out all heaviness, all spiritual debris, all negative energy that has attached to you.

As you work, say:

"This egg draws out everything that is not mine. Every attachment, every cord, every intention sent against me, every energy I have absorbed that does not belong to me — come into this egg. Leave my body. Leave my energy field. I am clean."

When finished, crack the egg into the glass of cold water. Add a pinch of salt and a sprig of rue or rosemary. Examine the egg in the water:

- Clear water, yolk intact and settled: you are energetically clean
- Bubbles or strings rising from the yolk: energy cords were removed; stress was present

- Cloudy or murky water: significant negativity was removed; consider repeating the cleanse for three days
- Blood spots or unusual shapes: something serious was removed; follow with a full seven-day uncrossing

Flush the egg down the toilet or pour it at a crossroads, never in your kitchen sink. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and cold water.

Chapter Seventeen

The Self-Dedication Ritual

A self-dedication ritual is a formal, personal commitment to your magical practice. It is not an initiation into a coven or tradition — it is a private vow between you and the universe, declaring that you take your practice seriously and that you commit to working with intention, integrity, and continuous growth.

This ritual is entirely optional. Many powerful practitioners never perform a formal dedication and their work is no less valid for it. But for those who feel called to mark their journey with a deliberate threshold moment — a before and after — this ritual provides exactly that.

There is no right time for this ritual. Some perform it when they begin. Others, like the reader of this volume, wait until they have sufficient experience to make the commitment with genuine understanding of what they are committing to. Both approaches are right.

Spell 43: The Home Witch's Self-Dedication Ritual

A private, personal ritual of commitment to your magical practice. Best performed at the New Moon, Full Moon, or on your birthday.

You Will Need

- A white candle (your primary dedication candle)
- A purple candle (for your spiritual path)
- Salt and water for self-cleansing
- A written dedication vow — in your own words
- Your journal (open to a blank page)
- Something that represents your practice — a crystal, a herb, a tool you use regularly

- Optional: your favourite incense

Steps

Cleanse the space thoroughly. Take a cleansing bath or shower before beginning. Dress in clean, comfortable clothing, ideally white or a colour that feels significant to you.

Set up your space with the two candles, your journal, your representative object, and whatever else feels meaningful. Light the incense if using.

Mix a small bowl of salt and water. Dip your fingers and anoint your forehead, throat, and heart centre — mind, voice, and heart — saying:

"I cleanse my mind of doubt. I cleanse my voice of fear. I cleanse my heart of all that would prevent me from walking this path with full commitment."

Light the white candle. Say:

"I stand at a threshold. What I was before this moment and what I am after are different. I choose to cross this threshold consciously and with full awareness."

Light the purple candle. Read your written dedication vow aloud. If you have not written one yet, here is a template to personalise:

"I, [your name], dedicate myself to this path of home witchcraft freely and in full awareness. I commit to practicing with intention and integrity. I commit to harming none including myself. I commit to continuing to learn. I commit to trusting my own power. I commit to using my magic for healing, abundance, justice, and love — for myself and for all those my life touches. I am a practitioner. I have always been

***a practitioner. I name it now. I claim it
now. So it is."***

Write the date and your name in your journal. Sit in silence for as long as feels right. You have just done something significant.

Let both candles burn completely. Keep the representative object on your altar permanently from this point forward, as a symbol of your commitment.

Spell 53: Annual Renewal Ritual — Recommit to Your Practice Each Year

A yearly ritual to review your growth and recommit to the path ahead. Best on your birthday, at Samhain, or at the New Year.

You Will Need

- Your magical journal from the past year
- A white and a gold candle
- Bay leaves — one for each significant spell cast this year
- A fireproof bowl

Steps

Sit with your magical journal from the past year. Spend at least thirty minutes reading through your entries — what you cast, what worked, what surprised you, what failed, what you learned. This is not a judgment session. It is a review of a year of serious practice.

On each bay leaf, write one word representing something significant from your practice this year — a breakthrough, a lesson, a spell that changed something. Light the gold candle.

Burn each bay leaf in the candle flame and drop it in the bowl, saying for each one:

***“I honour this. I have learned from this.
I carry what serves me and release
what is complete.”***

When all the bay leaves have burned, light the white candle from the gold one. Say:

***“I am not the same practitioner I was a
year ago. I have grown. I have
deepened. I have made mistakes and I

Let both candles burn for at least an hour. Open your fresh journal to the first page and write the date and one intention for your practice in the coming year.

Chapter Eighteen

Advanced Candle Magic Techniques

Volumes 1 and 2 covered candle basics: colours, dressing, reading the flame, the seven-day vigil candle. This chapter introduces advanced techniques that significantly amplify the power of any candle working.

Carving Candles

Carving symbols, names, words, or sigils into a candle before dressing it adds an additional layer of intention directly into the wax. Use a toothpick, a nail, or a dedicated carving tool. Carve while visualising your intention. Key things to carve: your name (or the target's), your desire in a single word, planetary symbols, the numbers 3, 7, or 9 (powerful magical numbers), or your personal sigil.

Loading Candles

Loading means inserting herbs, roots, or oils directly into the body of the candle. Use a warm implement to hollow out the bottom of the candle, insert your chosen ingredients, and seal the bottom with melted wax. The candle then carries those ingredients within itself throughout the working, releasing their energy as it burns.

Candle Trains

A candle train is a series of candles burned in sequence over multiple days to build toward a single goal. Each candle is placed slightly closer to a symbol of your goal (a petition, a photograph, a jar) than the last, physically representing the energy drawing nearer with each burn. Typically seven candles are used over seven days.

Spell 44: The Loaded Seven-Day Candle — Maximum Power Working

Combines carving, loading, dressing, and the seven-day vigil format into the most powerful single-candle working available.

You Will Need

- A seven-day glass vigil candle in the appropriate colour
- A skewer or toothpick
- Herbs and oils appropriate to your goal
- Your petition
- A carving tool

Steps

Before lighting: use the skewer to make a small hole in the top centre of the candle wax, going deep. Into this hole, place a combination of your chosen herbs (three types for maximum power), a drop of your chosen oil, and a tiny rolled piece of your petition.

On the outside of the glass, use a permanent marker or tape your petition to the outside. On the top surface of the wax, carve your name (or the target's) and a single word representing your desire.

Anoint the top surface with oil. Light on the appropriate day of the week and say:

"This candle is loaded with my full intention. Every layer works in concert. The herbs from the earth, the oil of my purpose, the word carved in wax, the petition sealed within — all speak the same truth. For seven days this burns and my desire grows with every hour. By the seventh day it is done."

Read the glass carefully when complete. A completely clean glass is the gold standard — it means the working succeeded without resistance.

Spell 45: The Candle Train — Drawing Your Goal Closer Day by Day

A seven-day working where each candle physically moves your desire closer to manifestation.

You Will Need

- Seven candles in the appropriate colour
- A photograph or symbol of your goal placed at one end of your working space
- A ruler or measuring tape

Steps

Place the photograph or goal symbol at one end of a flat surface — a shelf, a table, a windowsill. Measure 14 inches from it. This is where you light the first candle.

Each day, move the candle two inches closer to the goal symbol, lighting a new candle at the new position. On day one at 14 inches, on day two at 12 inches, on day three at 10 inches, and so on until on day seven the candle is touching the goal symbol.

As you light each candle, say:

"Day [number]. I am [number] days closer. My goal draws toward me. I draw toward my goal. The gap closes. The arrival approaches. By the seventh day we meet."

On the seventh day, when the candle is at the goal symbol, say:

"The distance is closed. What I sought is here in energy. Now it manifests in the physical world. The train has arrived. The working is complete."

Chapter Nineteen

Weather & Colour Magic

Two of the most ancient and accessible forms of magical practice: weather magic, which works with the living forces of the natural world around you, and colour magic, which uses the energetic language of colour to amplify and direct intention in every area of your life.

Both traditions are found in virtually every magical culture on earth. Both are practical, immediate, and available to any practitioner. Once you understand the energetics of weather and colour, you will never look at a rainy day or a red dress the same way again.

Weather Magic — Working With the Elements in Motion

Weather magic works with the weather — using the energetic qualities of rain, wind, sun, thunder, and snow as amplifiers and partners. A money spell cast in sunshine carries solar abundance energy. A banishing performed in a thunderstorm is supercharged by the storm's own clearing force. A love ritual in soft rain is infused with the gentle, flowing quality of water energy at its most natural.

Colour Magic — The Language of Vibration

Every colour carries a specific vibration that affects the human nervous system, the subconscious mind, and the energetic field around us. When you choose a red candle for passion or a green one for money, you are using colour's energetic language. This chapter teaches you to extend that knowledge far beyond candles.



Spell 54: Rain Spell — Wash Away Grief, Blockage, or Negativity

Cast during or just before rain. Rain is one of the most powerful natural cleansing forces available.

You Will Need

- An open window or safe outdoor space
- Something representing what you wish to wash away (a written description, a photo, or an object)
- Your willingness to let the rain do its work

Steps

When rain begins or is imminent, take your representation of the issue to an open window or step safely outside. Feel the rain energy — that quality of the air that feels like the world is being cleaned. Say:

“Rain, you clean everything you touch. Clean this too. Wash away [name the specific issue]. Take it from me and from my life. Let it dissolve as you dissolve. Let it flow away as you flow away. I stand here clean when this rain passes.”

Hold the representation out into the rain if safely possible, or hold it at the open window where the rain’s energy reaches. When the rain lightens or stops, destroy the representation — burn it, flush it, or bury it. The issue has been given to the rain.

Spell 55: Storm Spell — Break Through a Serious Obstacle With Thunder Energy

Cast during a thunderstorm. Storm energy is the most powerful natural force for breaking through entrenched blockages. Never cast this for minor issues.

You Will Need

- A black candle (lit safely indoors)
- A piece of paper describing the obstacle

Steps

During a thunderstorm, stand at your window safely inside and feel the raw power of the storm. Light the black candle. Write the obstacle on the paper in large clear letters. Hold it toward the storm and say — aloud, with full conviction:

“Storm, I ask your power. This obstacle — [name it specifically] — has stood long enough. With the force of your thunder and the clarity of your lightning, break this open. Clear this path. Move what has refused to move. I add my will to your force. Together we are stronger than any blockage.”

Burn the paper in the black candle’s flame. Let the candle burn down. After the storm passes and it is safe, go outside and stand in the aftermath. That quality of clarity in the air after a storm? That is what your obstacle now feels like. Broken. Cleared. Done.

On a sunny day, before beginning your primary spell, take your candle, herbs, crystals, petition, or tools, and hold them up in direct sunlight for at least three minutes. As the sun falls on your tools, say:

“Sun, charge these tools with your abundance, your confidence, your power of growth, and your clarity. Every working I perform with these today carries your light within it. What I cast is amplified by your force.”

Then proceed with your primary spell as normal. Solar charging adds vitality, confidence, and success energy to whatever you are working on. Particularly powerful for money, career, confidence, and love spells.

Steps

Every morning when you dress, you make a magical choice whether you know it or not. The colours you wear affect how others perceive you, how you perceive yourself, and what energy you carry through your day. This working makes that choice conscious and intentional.

Before opening your wardrobe, state your primary intention for the day. Then choose colours accordingly:

- Red — courage, passion, dominance, commanding attention, physical energy
- Pink — love, approachability, charm, drawing affection and warmth
- Orange — ambition, creativity, fast results, standing out in a crowd
- Yellow or gold — confidence, communication, intellectual clarity, success
- Green — money, growth, healing, harmony, abundance
- Blue — trust, calm authority, peaceful communication, healing
- Purple — spiritual power, mystery, command, psychic sensitivity
- Black — protection, authority, banishing negative attention, power
- White — purity, fresh starts, clarity, peace, all-purpose energy

As you dress, say: “I wear [colour] for [intention] today. It works with me and for me.” If you cannot wear the colour outwardly (workwear, uniform), wear it as underwear, socks, or jewellery. The energy still works.

- Pink and gold — attract a confident, worthy partner
- Green and purple — financial authority, business leadership
- Red and black — passionate protection, fierce boundary energy
- Blue and white — peaceful clarity, honest communication
- Orange and green — fast money, rapid career growth
- Purple and white — spiritual authority with peaceful intention

Place the two candles side by side. Dress each with its appropriate oil. Light them simultaneously. Say:

“Two colours, one intention. [Colour 1] brings [its quality]. [Colour 2] brings [its quality]. Together they work as one force for [your complete goal]. Neither alone is enough. Together they are exactly what is needed.”

Let both candles burn together. If one burns higher, that aspect of your goal needs more attention. Balance your efforts accordingly.

The colour bath absorbs the energetic frequency of a chosen colour directly through the skin and into your aura. It is one of the fastest ways to shift your personal energy into the frequency you need.

- Pink bath — self-love, attracting affection (rose petals or pink food colouring)
- Green bath — prosperity, healing, growth (fresh basil or green food colouring)
- Blue bath — peace, clarity, cooling anger (blue cornflowers or blue food colouring)
- Yellow bath — confidence, joy, mental energy (chamomile flowers)
- Purple bath — spiritual power, psychic sensitivity (lavender)

Light the candle in your chosen colour. Run the bath. Add the colouring or petals. As you lower yourself in, say:

“I absorb the energy of [colour]. It enters through my skin and fills my aura. By the time I emerge, I carry [state the quality] in every cell and in every layer of my energy field. I step out changed.”

Soak for at least fifteen minutes. Air dry where possible to let the energy settle. Do not use chemical dyes on broken or irritated skin.

- Seven small pieces of paper
- A pen
- The full moon

Steps

Arrange the seven candles in a line: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple, white. On each piece of paper, write one intention corresponding to that colour's energy. Fold each toward you and place it beneath its candle.

Light all seven candles in order from red to white. As you light each one, state its intention aloud. When all seven are lit, hold your hands over the full array and say:

“Seven colours, seven intentions, one full moon. The complete spectrum of my desire is lit and sent. Red for action, orange for ambition, yellow for clarity, green for abundance, blue for peace, purple for wisdom, white for purity of path. All seven are real. All seven are working. All seven align with my highest good. Under this full moon, they are sealed.”

Sit with all seven candles until they have burned at least halfway. You may let them burn over the following nights,

lighting them in the same order each time. The seven intentions work together throughout the coming month, each feeding the others.

Power Ingredient: Lavender — for purification and peace

March — The Worm Moon

Moon Focus: Balance, new growth, equal light and dark

Best Spells This Month: Ostara workings, new beginnings, planting intention seeds literally and magically, balance spells

Best Spells This Month: Love and passion spells, creativity workings, fire magic, business launch blessings

Power Ingredient: Rose — for love, beauty, and passion

June — The Strawberry Moon

Moon Focus: The longest light, peak solar energy, Litha power

Best Spells This Month: Success and confidence workings, solar charging, career domination, maximum-power manifestation of any kind

Power Ingredient: Cinnamon — for speed, success, and fire energy

July — The Buck Moon

Moon Focus: Strength, vitality, the height of summer power

Best Spells This Month: Personal power spells, healing workings, prosperity at its fullest, travel protection for summer journeys

Power Ingredient: Ginger — for power, energy, and strength

August — The Sturgeon Moon

How to Use This Calendar

At the start of each month, review the energetic theme and plan which spells from this series are best aligned with that month's energy. A prosperity spell cast in April (growth energy) will move faster than the same spell cast in November (inward, quiet energy). You work with the current rather than against it.

For exact New and Full Moon dates each month, consult a moon phase calendar for your specific location — these are available free online and as apps. The New Moon is always the best time to begin a working. The Full Moon is always the best time for maximum-power castings. The Waning Moon is always the best time for banishing and release.

Appendix B

The Witch's Complete Shopping List

One of the most common questions from home practitioners is: what do I actually need to buy, and where do I buy it? This appendix answers both questions completely. Everything here is affordable, available, and practical.

Candles — Your Most-Used Tool

Where to buy: Grocery stores, pound shops, discount stores, dollar stores, Amazon. Do NOT buy expensive decorative candles for spellwork — plain, unscented candles in the correct colour are what matter.

- White candles: always have at least 10 in stock. Taper, pillar, or tea light all work
- Black candles: keep 6 on hand for protection and banishing
- Red candles: 4–6 for love and courage workings
- Green candles: 4–6 for money workings
- Pink candles: 4–6 for self-love and gentle love magic
- Purple candles: 4 for domination and spiritual work
- Orange candles: 4 for fast results and ambition
- Blue candles: 4 for healing and communication
- Gold or yellow candles: 4 for success and career
- Seven-day glass vigil candles in white, green, red, black, purple: 2 of each to have ready

Herbs — Your Spice Rack is Your Pharmacy

Where to buy: Supermarket spice aisle for most; spiritual supply stores or Amazon for specialty roots and herbs.

- Rosemary: large jar — most versatile protection herb
- Cinnamon: large jar — essential for money and speed workings

- Basil: large jar — for money and love
- Bay leaves: one packet — keep topped up, you'll burn many
- Mint: fresh or dried — for money and communication
- Thyme: for courage and purification
- Sage: for cleansing (loose dried, not in a bundle unless preferred)
- Lavender: for peace, psychic work, and sleep
- Cloves: for fast money and protection
- Black pepper: for banishing
- Ginger: for fire energy and power
- Chamomile: for money and relaxation
- Specialty items from spiritual supply stores: hyssop, rue, calamus root, master root, mugwort, lucky hand root

Oils — For Dressing and Anointing

Where to buy: Health food stores, Amazon, spiritual supply stores. Essential oils are small bottles — they last a long time.

- Frankincense essential oil: spiritual work, protection, elevation
- Rose essential oil or rose absolute: love, glamour, beauty
- Peppermint essential oil: money, energy, clarity
- Lavender essential oil: peace, psychic work, healing
- Bergamot essential oil: success, authority, money
- Clary sage essential oil: psychic work, third eye
- Cinnamon oil: speed, success (dilute in carrier oil — cinnamon is strong)
- Jojoba or almond carrier oil: for diluting essential oils and as a neutral dressing oil
- Olive oil: all-purpose anointing and dressing oil — already in your kitchen

Crystals — Buy Once, Use Forever

Where to buy: New age shops, Amazon, eBay, crystal fairs, charity shops (crystals donated are often powerful). You do not need expensive crystals — a small tumbled stone is just as effective as a large polished sphere.

- Clear quartz: 2–3 pieces — amplifies everything
- Black tourmaline: 2 pieces — protection
- Rose quartz: 2 pieces — love and self-worth
- Citrine: 1–2 pieces — money and joy
- Amethyst: 1–2 pieces — psychic work and peace
- Obsidian: 1 piece — protection and truth
- Pyrite: 1 piece — money and confidence
- Moonstone: 1 piece — lunar work and intuition
- Black tourmaline: 1 extra piece for travel protection

Tools — The Essentials

- A dedicated journal for your Book of Shadows (any notebook will do)
- A fireproof bowl or cauldron for burning — a small metal bowl from a kitchen shop works perfectly
- Glass jars with lids in various sizes — save jam jars and pasta sauce jars
- Cotton cord or string in black, red, white, green, and purple — available from craft shops
- A small mirror (pocket mirror or compact mirror)
- Sea salt: always have a large supply
- Black salt: buy or make your own (mix sea salt with ash from burned protective herbs)
- A lighter or box of matches (wooden matches carry earth energy)
- A compass for elemental workings (your phone compass works fine)

Specialty Items — From Spiritual Supply Stores

Where to buy: Search online for 'spiritual supply store', 'conjure supply', 'botanica', or 'hoodoo supplies'. Many excellent shops ship internationally.

- Lodestone and magnetic sand: for attraction workings
- Florida water: for ancestral work and space cleansing
- Reversing candles (black outside, red inside): for reversal and hex-breaking work
- Calamus root: for domination and commanding
- Master root: for absolute authority workings
- Lucky hand root: for luck and opportunity
- Hyssop and rue: for serious uncrossing and cleansing
- A black mirror: for scrying (or make your own as described in Chapter Seven)

Approximate Budget

Starting from scratch with the basics above: approximately £60–£80 / \$75–\$100 USD will stock your practice completely. Many of the herbs are already in your kitchen. Once established, your monthly spend on replenishing candles and herbs should be approximately £10–£15 / \$15–\$20.

Magic does not require wealth. It requires intention.

Appendix E

Advanced Glossary of Magical Terms

This glossary covers advanced and tradition-specific terms used in Volume 3 that were not included in the Volume 2 Beginner's Glossary.

Ancestor altar

A dedicated space for communicating with and honouring deceased family members, teachers, or spiritual guides. Typically includes photographs, water, a candle, and offerings.

Ceromancy

The art of divination through reading melted wax. One of the oldest forms of candle divination, practiced across European, African, and Latin American traditions.

Copal

A tree resin used as incense in Mesoamerican spiritual tradition, particularly for ancestral communication and cleansing. Similar to frankincense in its elevating properties.

Crossed condition

A state of spiritual interference or blockage, often the result of a hex or jinx. Characterised by persistent bad luck, obstacles, and a sense of heaviness. Treated with uncrossing work.

Divination

The practice of seeking knowledge of the future or the unknown through magical means. Includes tarot, scrying, wax reading, dream interpretation, and many other methods.

Elevated ancestors

Ancestors who have moved beyond the pain and limitation of their earthly lives and now stand in wisdom and love. These are the ancestors most beneficial to work with, regardless of whether your blood ancestors were good people.

Florida water

A cologne-based spiritual water used in Latin American and hoodoo traditions for cleansing, ancestor offerings, and uplifting the vibration of a space. Named for the 'flower'ry' fragrance, not the state.

Hex

A working of deliberate ill intent directed at a specific person. Distinguished from a jinx (usually accidental) and a curse (more serious and sustained).

Iron

A metal used universally across magical traditions as a ward against negative spirits and psychic attack. Iron disrupts harmful energetic transmissions.

Jar spell

A spell contained within a sealed glass jar. The contents create the energetic environment; the sealing locks the working in place. Works continuously until dissolved.

Limpieza

The Spanish term for a spiritual cleansing, particularly the egg cleanse practiced in Latin American curanderismo and folk magic traditions.

Loading (a candle)

Inserting herbs, roots, or oils into the body of a candle before burning, to embed additional intention directly within the wax.

Lodestone

A naturally occurring magnetic rock used in folk magic and hoodoo to attract desired people, situations, love, or money. Fed with magnetic sand to maintain its power.

Petition

A written magical request directed to the universe, ancestors, or a spiritual force. One of the most precise and powerful forms of spellwork due to the specificity it demands.

Reversal

The conscious dissolution of a previously cast spell, or the redirection of a harmful working back to its sender.

Rue

A powerful protective and uncrossing herb used particularly in Mediterranean and Latin American magic. Also used in the hoodoo tradition. Has a strong, distinctive scent.

Scrying

The practice of gazing into a reflective surface — a mirror, water, crystal ball, or flame — to receive psychic impressions, images, or information.

Self-dedication

A personal ritual in which a practitioner formally commits to their magical path. Not an initiation into a tradition but a private vow of commitment.

Vigil candle

A glass-encased candle designed to burn for an extended period (typically five to seven days). The glass is read after the candle burns out to assess the working.

War water

A traditional hoodoo formula made by rusting iron nails in water, used for protection against active enemies and the return of harmful energy.

Witch's ladder

A cord strung with nine objects, each charged with a specific intention. Hung in the home as a continuous charm. One of the oldest forms of charm magic in European tradition.
